ABOUT THE CALL

Through the “Norway for You - Montenegro” project, the Kingdom of Norway earmarked 250,000 Euros to support social inclusion by improving living conditions in the 16 underdeveloped municipalities of Montenegro, through improvement of physical infrastructure.

The Call was published on 26 November 2019 and all interested parties were able to submit their applications until 20 January 2020 for improvement of the living conditions in the underdeveloped municipalities of Montenegro through construction, reconstruction or renovation.

One info session was organized in Podgorica on 6 December 2019 attended by 26 participants from almost all municipalities included in the project.

1.	Andrijevica and Berane	52,340	5,838	58,778	The project envisages adaptation of two mountain lodges: Suvodol, located in the Municipality of Andrijevica and Krivi Do in the Municipality of Berane. The project is focused on improving and strengthening inter-municipal cooperation in developing joint tourism opportunities in the areas of Jelovica and Bjelasica mountains.
2.	Gusinje	33,452	4,049	37,501	The project envisages construction of the public lighting infrastructure in a new part of the city, covering all households located in four streets.
3.	Mojkovac	22,160	2,462	24,622	Project includes installation of two water pumps for the water supply of part of the Municipality of Mojkovac. Two local communities comprising 800 households are planned for water supply encasement.
4.	Plav and Petnjica	54,650	8,247	62,897	The project is focused on empowerment of local producers to sell their traditional agriculture products by procurement and installation of five wooden houses/shops in the centre of the Municipality of Petnjica and five wooden houses/shops in Plav city centre.
5.	Pljevlja	31,980	4,097	36,077	Project is focused on sustainable management of municipal wastewater, by installing two wastewater treatment plants near the facilities of the City Stadium and the Vodice. Currently there is no existing system of waste management and sewerage was directly discharged into the river.
6.	Rožaje	30,210	3,357	33,567	Project is focused on constructing several sport and recreational terrains in Brezovacko Brdo, a forest area located in the suburb of Municipality of Rožaje. This intervention is part of the strategy of the local self-government to protect the environment and emphasize the tourist potential of the municipality.
7.	Žabljak	26,604	3,079	29,683	Project envisages construction of the new sewerage network and connections to the existing network in the centre of Žabljak and connection to the new public centralized system.
